

## **KARNATAKA HIGH COURT DELIVERS A LANDMARK JUDGEMENT**



### **EMPLOYEES WHO RESIGNED FROM SERVICE OF THE BANKS AFTER COMPLETING 20 YEARS OF SERVICE, ARE ELIGIBLE FOR PENSION**

The High Court of Karnataka at Bangalore in a land mark judgement in the case of Sri. C.Narasimhappa and others Vs Vijaya Bank, have ordered that the petitioners who have completed 20 years or more of service, though have resigned from the service of the Bank are entitled for Pension and the respondent Bank should extend the benefit of pension to all the petitioners.

In the case of WP No.24158 – 24160/2011, perusing the evidence placed before the Hon. Judge, he has given a very well reasoned order that, the petitioners are eligible for pensionary benefits, as all of them have completed more than 20 years of service, the minimum qualifying service for pension and merely because the pensioners have resigned from service, is not a ground for denying the pension.
